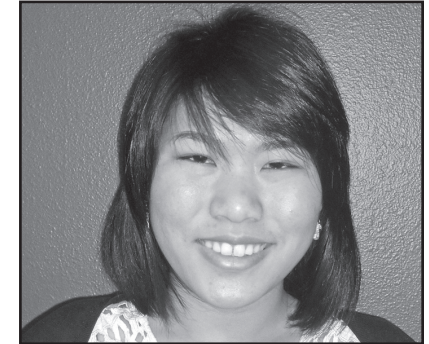
MATHEW KRANE
